THOMAS MILAM, born Halifax Co., Va. 1757, son of John & Judith (Bartlett Cole) Milam died Laurens Co., S.C. c. 1818

1. MILAM FAMILY CHART by Mrs. Leona Betteridge, Tacoma, Wash. 98466 (copy submitted with DAR Application), shows Thomas (b.1757) son of JOHN MILAM
2. Letter of Jim L. Milum, 607 Skyline Drive, Harrison, Ark. 72601 dated Sep 1983, confirming MILAM family history: "my information is the same as yours". Jim L. Milum is Secretary of the Jordan Milam Chapter, S.A.R., Harrison, Arkansas; Joran Milam was nephew of JOHN MILAM
3. Letter of Mrs. Laura Madden Pulley, Chm. Lineage Research Committee, Sullivan-Dunklin DAR Chapter, Rt 1, Isle O'Pines, Waterloo, SC 29384, dated 20 Aug. 1972 (copy submitted with DAR Application): "My records state that four of John of Va.'s sons came to SC, namely Captain John, Benjamin, THOMAS and my Bartlett who did not come until last (1796)."
4. Thomas Milam appears on Halifax Co., Va. Tax List 1785: 3 males 0 females
5. Thomas Milam married (2nd) 12 June 1786 Elizabeth Talbert in Halifax Co., Va. (Va. Marriage Records) Will BK A-12 p 35 York Co SC John Milam 3 Jun 1789 p 28 Aug 1789 Thomas, Seb Ex.
6. Thomas Milam appears in US Census, Laurens Co., SC 1790 with 2 males under 16 (thought to be Coleman and John Milam, his sons) and 3 females. wife, dau & mother
7. Thomas Milam appears in US Census, 1800, Laurens Co., SC with 2 males 10/16, (thought to be ~~John~~ & John), 2 males under 10; he is 26/45 (actually 43); 2 females under 10 and his wife 26/25. (2nd wife)
8. Thomas Milam appears in US Census, 1810 Laurens Co., SC and not in 1820.
9. Elizabeth Milam, widow (of Thomas), appears US Census 1830 Franklin Co., Tenn. next door to her step-son COLEMAN MILAM.
10. There was no other Thomas Milam in S.C. until 1796 when Bartlett Milam brought his son Thomas, born 2 Mar 1785 in Va., who married c.1818 Rachel Bell Jones (1800-1868). As Mrs. Pulley points out in her letter 20 Aug 1972: "SC Equity Court Roll #1923, dated 23 Oct 1817, showing John Milam (brother of Coleman Milam who accompanied him and their step-mother Elizabeth Milam to Tennessee), son of Thomas" (note: this is proof evidence) This had to be Thomas son of John of Va., since Thomas, son of Bartlett and Elizabeth, married Rachel Bell Jones and their children are not born until the 1820's."

11. Deed Bk J p 215 7 Feb 1811 Thomas Milam with deed of Charles Little & wife to James Leake 180 A \$250 on Duncan Creek.
12. Deed Bk J p 224 Thomas Milam owns land bordering 200 A on Duncan Creek which Robert Crowell sold to James Leake for \$350; said 200 A sold by Sheriff John Clark to said Robert Crowell as former property of Ashford Clary, wif. C. Layton

13. 29 Oct 1817 (Laurens Dist Roll # 1923) "John Milam, son of Thomas Milam" indebted to the firm of Dunlap & Underwood for \$34. Judgment granted 13 Dec 1817.
15. 1830 Census, Franklin Co., Tenn: Elizabeth (Talbert, widow of Thomas) Milam, next door to step-son Coleman Milam
