Wm Miles of Ashepoo, eldest son of Wm, formerly of St. George's & late of Ashepoo, deceased, to John Miles of Horse Savannah, 506 A. in St. Barth. south side Ashepoo River swamp - part of 806 A granted 1 May 1734 to grandfather Wm. Miles

* 14 Mar. 1767 (1763-67 p. 581) Guardianship of Ann, Rachel, Eliz. & Susannah Miles (minor ch. of Silas, deceased) granted to Job McPherson (their uncle)

* Silas on 3 May 1763 to John Miles, Sr. of St. Pauls; ^{1000 A St. Barth.} grant to Thos. 7 July 1733; Thos. by will 13 Oct. 1750 to son Silas 500 A of ad tract; division between Silas & Bro. John.

+ Rosamond Perry aged 68 10 Apr. 1773 (b. 1705)

Thos. Cates & Rachel (wife) St. Peters 8 June 1773 sell 318 A in St. George's to Thos. Kellar of St. Geo.

Wm McTeer of granville mentions "niece Martha Miles"

John & Keziah Miles of St. Pauls sell to Gabriel Harvey 24 Jan. 1791 802 A. St. Barth. (Keziah (widow of Joseph Perry) m. John 27 Jan. 1774. Job & Ulysses McP. (Trustees)

John & Ann (22 May 1771) of Colleton; to John Ainslie of St George District "whereas John did mortgage to Wm & Joseph Miles the inheritance of Ann, plantation of 500 A granted 14 Mar 1705 to Capt. Jonathan Fitch in St. Pauls.

Ann Elliott (dan. Thos.) m ① Jonathan Fitch ② Roger Saunders ③ - waigent in her will D. & P. 1748 left 500 A. in St Pauls to gr. dan. Ann Fitch.

Ann Fitch, spr. one of the two only children, daughters & co-heirs of Jonathan Fitch, Jr. who died intestate, & also one of the grandchildren of Ann Waite, deceased & a legatee of her will;

Isabella Fitch (her sister) is dead & Ann hath issue by John Miles p. 172 (1765-6) p. 22 Dec. 1767
