Ann (20-87) dau. of Ann Butler miles (dau. of Thos. Butler of Schiaveling + Pr. Wms. + 1746) m. Joseph Ainger.

Ed. (20-80)'s widow, Eliz. Mellichamp m. @ 1766 Thos. Fuller of "Pierponts" Plantation

Wm (20-83) bought 216 A "The Ferry Tract" from Hugh Cartwright, left it to son (?) John Miles who sold 86 A to Ed. Legge before 1771.

Wm (20-84) Trustee for Mrs. Sarah Frazer (John + Sarah Frazer, pronounced Frazer) tr. several parcels of land including above 86 A to Wm as Trustee for Sarah - dau. of Zacharias Ladson; s. m. John Frazer in 1770

Wm (20-84) bought 313 A from Josiah + Rebecca Butler Baker ↑ 2 Feb. 1738; later called "Savages" + annexed to Schiaveling (left it to John Miles who sold to Jeremiah Savage)

Wm (20-96) m. Eliz. dau. Robert Ladson + Sabina Rose, dau. Thomas Rose of Accabee; Eliz. m. @ her cousin Robert Ladson (cousin's 2nd wife) Eliz. inherited 400 A. of what is now Magnolia Gardens.

James (21-156) of Chas. m. Rachel, dau. Samuel Parcher, Esq.; deceased of St. Peter's Par, Tues 23 Apr. 1793.

Reziah miles (21-122) m. Thos. Lee 9 Feb. 1792 (dau. John, Esq. of Horse-Savannah)
