John Champneys Tunno married at Charleston, S.C. by Rev. Dr. Gadson, Rector of St. Phillips Church, to Elizabeth Millichamp Miles, January 15, 1824. John Champneys Tunno died in S.C. May 22, 1859, age 63. Interred at St. Paul's Church, Pendleton Village, now dist. of S. Charleston, S.C. Their children:

1. Mary Ann Rose Tunno, born March 21, 1825. Died in Summerville, S.C., November 20, 1860. Interred at Charleston, S.C.
2. John Champneys Tunno, born January 4, 1827, Charleston, S.C. Name changed to John Tunno Champneys. Died December, ~~1842~~ 1892.

4. Adam Tunno, born Charleston, S.C., October 7, 1831. Died Glynn Co., Ga., June 26, 1832. Interred at Christ Church, St. Simons, Island, Ga.

III John Tunno Champneys married April 27, 1864 at Rosedale, Loundes Co., Miss. by Rt. Rev. Green, Bishop of the Dist. of Miss. to Ozella Kezia Topp, youngest and third daughter of William Wallace Topp, M.D. of Loundes Co., Miss. Their children:
