2. John Norton, in 1724 deeded lands inherited from his deceased mother, Sarah Fitch Norton, under 1705 will of his father, to his brother, George Norton; died Nov. 1732.
3. George Norton m. 27 Oct. 1720 Elizabeth Connaway; their dau., Sarah Norton, m. 7 July 1746 Samuel Ladson, Jr.; their son, George Norton, was born 11 Feb. 1726.
4. JONATHAN NORTON (14 July 1705-28 April 1774), planter of 596-acre plantation on St. Helena's Island; Vestryman of St. Helena's Parish 8 April 1751, Overseer of the poor for St. Helena's Parish 25 Apr. 1762; married 16 May 1732 MARY ANN CHAPLIN (22 July 1716-10 Jan. 1764, dau. of John Chaplin and his wife, Phoebe Ladson. Jonathan & Mary Ann Norton in 1756 deeded two (2) acres of 960 acres granted to his father, John Norton, on St. Helena's Is. for a Chapel of Ease for St. Helena's Parish. Jonathan Norton made his will 14 Apr. 1774; issue.
5. Dorothy Norton m. John Cowen who was buried at St. Helena's 5 July 1752; their dau., Sarah Cowen m. 27 Jan. 1728 William Hazzard (1709-9 Aug 1741, son of Col Wm + Sarah Hazzard); m. (2) 9 Dec 1742 John Catlett (27 Dec. 1749)
6. Jane Norton m. (1) Thomas Haydon (will 23 Feb. 1730, proved 29 March 1730 (Will. Bk. 1729-1731, CPC, p. 374) names son John Haydon, dau. Hannah Haydon; Executors: wife and brother-in-law Jonathan Norton); m. (2) Thomas Goreing.
7. Sarah Norton, (buried 16 Jan. 1739) m. Randolph Evans: son: John Evans m. 30 Apr. 1741 Elizabeth Chaplin, dau. of John Chaplin and wife Phoebe Ladson, their issue included: John Evans, born 24 Jan. 1748, married by Rev. Evans 27 Nov. 1766 Sarah Fripp, dau. of John Fripp, and their daughter, Elizabeth Evans, born 16 Sept. 1767 was married by Rev. Wm. Graham 4 July 1782 to Joseph Jenkins of Edisto (buried Oct. 1827), a son, John Evans, was born 25 Aug. 1768.
