Jonathan - This name is wrongly placed. John Norton was the first son, and it was he who married Martha Phoebe Perry, <sup>1767</sup> and had the 2 children listed there, who did not survive long. Probably you can erase part of the word "Jonathan", substituting John. Then place Jonathan underneath. This Jonathan did not live long. Will soon send you a complete copy of the "Norton" page in the St. Helena Register, so you can add - on next page - the children in order of their birth, just as they appear in register. Mr. Hartbridge says Mrs. Hadahan is a very competent genealogist - he has had one letter from her in re to some ancestor of Susan, his wife. Said please to ask her if she has anything on the name Lengel - or L'Engle, from whom Susan also des-

ends. He did not spell it out, so I am not sure of spelling.
