Two Charleston Students Win Woodrow Wilson Fellowships

Two Charleston college students have been named winners of Woodrow Wilson Fellowships for 1967-68 graduate studies.

They are Miss Josephine Trenholm Humphreys, an English major at Duke University, and Donald Richard Peeples, a mathematics major at Florida State University.

The fellowships provide a year of graduate work at the institution of the student's

choice, including tuition and fees, a \$2,000 living stipend and supplementary grant to the school.

Miss Humphreys was graduated at the top of her class from Ashley Hall in 1963. She received the Angier B. Duke Memorial Scholarship to Duke University, where she is a Phi Beta Kappa.

She is a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. William W. Humphreys of 29 Tradd St.

Peeples, a three-year student at Florida State, is a 1964 graduate of St. Andrew's High School. He achieved a perfect score in mathematics in his college entrance examinations and also received a perfect mark in the math area of his graduate record examination last fall.
