JOHN COUNTS arrived SC 1749 from Rotterdam as shown in SC Council Journal 1749 and was granted 350 acres 1 Dec. 1749 on a branch of Crim's Creek, Newberry Co.; with him were his wife and five children including John (father of George Counts), Henry, Jacob and Francina Counts who married George Riser and had a daughter Mary Riser (1781-1860) who m. 1797 Jacob Copeland, Jr. (1776-1853) by whom she had a daughter, SARAH Copeland (1813-1844) who m. 1834 LEVI FOLK (1815-1848) and had a son: Jacob Levi Folk (1837-1885) who m. 1858 Elizabeth Anne Weissinger (1833-1904), parents of Ellison Capers Folk (1869-1934) m. 1890 Mary Olive Elizabeth Folk (1868-1895), parents of Margaret Anne Folk (1894-1983) who m. 1915 Robert Rhodes Peeples (1890-1947)
