V Charles Isaac Chouin, died 1754,
married Elizabeth Robert, widow Elias
Quendon, on 25th August 1751 Christ
Church Parish

IV Charles Isaac Chauvin and Elizabeth Robert (Gaudon) had one child, a son, Charles Chauvin. After Isaac Chauvin's death, Elizabeth Robert Gaudon Chauvin married for her third husband the widower, William Chicken on 14 May 1761. Witness was John Robert. St. James Parish Register

III Charles Chauvin born 1753, d. 1790, married Sarah Guerin on 12 July 1779. (bapt. 11 Sept. 1763)

He was a planter and shoemaker in St. James Parish D 17 Aug. 1790 Pod. 29 Dec. 1790

Following Charles' death Sarah Guerin Chauvin married 2nd Peter Steel at St. Philip's Church Charleston in 1791.

It is interesting to note that Sarah Chauvin Killingham married secondly Elias Gabriel Gaudon both were grandchildren of Elizabeth Robert's brother Chauvin.
