ANN HENRIETTA RHODES (11-65) dated 25 Dec. 1830, a marriage settlement

with Morton A. Waring, Jr.... "We intend to marry, God willing". Concerns what Ann Henrietta R. is due from the Estate of Dr. Nathaniel Henry Rhodes, M.D. & from the Estate of Dr. John Rhodes, M.D., of Beaufort District and Richland Dist. in the State of S.C.... The bride to have complete control of what is due her from these two estates. Wit. Richard Scriven, T. Smith Waring before John Ward, J.P.

Thomas Rhodes, now of S.C. (2-424) dated 9 June 1795, a marriage settlement with Mary Wright, Spinster, daughter of the late John Wright of Charleston.... The bride deeds her estate to Keating Simons as her trustee, mentions 10 slaves and a plantation on the Pee Dee River bought of John Palmer Esq. and also her moiety in the Estate of the late John Wright and plantation on Wassamaw. Wit. Elizabeth Wright and Edward Simons. m. 10 July 1795 St. Phil. p'sch., Chas.
