

"Description of Arms"

Black & silver are called the colors of the 2nd Crusade, and the combination is found in many ancient arms. The greyhound (from grew hound) is a sign of messenger of the King.

There is no motto to the Grayson family coat of arms on account of its antiquity."

FOREWORD

There may be some errors in the information in this book. If so, I regret it, but I have checked and rechecked with all of written information sent to me. Sometimes a mother, brother or sister would give dates etc.; where one has been heard directly from that, is the date used. In a few cases descendants have requested their names and families left out of the record. Occasionally a son or daughter has asked that her father's name not be put in. If it is in, it shows that the mother gave it and that her wishes have priority. I have tried to concede with known wishes. I have traced every Bible possible for authentic dates. Much information was given person-to-person.

INTRODUCTION

This book is dedicated to my mother, Mrs. Austin Bennett Grayson. For a period of fifteen years she assumed the task of obtaining information about her husband's family. His ancestor, William Gracen, was known of through Bible records possessed now by his descendants. Mrs. James Fulton Grayson, widow, and her two children have the Bible of William Gracen, with entries made in it in his own handwriting. They also have in their possession the Bible of William John Grayson, son of William. The Bernard Buckner Grayson (brother of William John) Bible is now in the possession of Mrs. Vibert Graham whose first husband was L. M. Grayson. William Gracen's sister, Elizabeth Ann (unmarried) lived with him. Their tombstones substantiate the Bible Record Dates. However the descendants of their brother, Edward who married Ann Sarah Burgess, were unknown. By chance, my mother located one of these descendants, Mr. L. A. Grayson. He supplied other names and addresses. From then on it was a matter of persistent research. The names of the key people, who helped, are as follows:—Mesdames—James F. Grayson, Ervin Graham, David W. Fender, T. W. Pryor, and Messers—Leland A. Grayson, James W. Preacher and Dudley W. Knox. Commandant Knox helped especially by searching out the census records at the Archives in Washington, D. C.

At the age of eighty, my mother turned over to me all her information and her unfinished task. When I realized what a tremendous wealth of information had been garnered, I conceived the idea of bringing the record up to date, though the year of 1952. I hoped to publish it the following year. Circumstances kept delaying the printing of the book, however, until now. I did accomplish my goal after my correspondence, many personal visits, cemetery searches and record searching in the state. I was able to ferret out every living descendant, thereby obtaining authentic and detailed information. A few of these descendants, however, withheld their families for various reasons. This lack of information will cause hurt and confusion in the future, because the next few generations will not understand "why" their families were left out of the book.

The expense of all the above research was paid personally by both Mrs. Grayson and myself. There has been no financial gain to either of us. There was one exception, where six interested people voluntarily donated money to pay a genealogist in Ireland. The unused portions of this money were refunded to Mrs. J. F. Grayson; Mrs. V. Graham, Mrs. George Sheldon and Mr. D. W. Knox, Mr. E. C. Grayson. I was the sixth donater. Several were kind enough to donate their refunds toward expense of postage stamps. The information sent from the genealogist in Ireland has not been "Proved" to connect with our first ancestors, in this country, namely—John and Isabella (Skilling) Gracen.

Here are some facts to prove that our search for the marriage date of this couple seems hopeless, unless a "Known" old Bible comes to light. The first census was made in 1787 for 1790. John Gracen's name is not found in this or any other census.

All land grants were given out in 1775, in Prince William Parish, Beaufort District, S. C.—so John's name does not appear on a land grant. They are supposed to have come to S. C. about that time. The census records of 1850 William and Edward show the former born in S. C. in 1777; the latter in 1787 in S. C.

William Skilling is in the 1790 census. Isabella Skilling is said to have had a brother, William, and a sister, Kate, to come over to America with her. Mr. James W. Preacher told of seeing the names of John Gracen and his wife—Isabella (Skilling) Gracen and their marriage date of 1775—in an old Bible in his family. This is our only source of information as to their names and dates, except that the names of both go on down in the family. This Bible is lost, but I hope that it will somehow show up somewhere. Old Sheldon Church, The Prince William Parish Church, was burned several times, thus destroying the birth, marriage and death records of people living in this Parish.

The "Old Skilling Cemetery," near Early Branch, S. C. (Where John Gracen lived) had no headstones before 1822; nor could their graves be found in adjacent cemeteries.

At Columbia, S. C., at the Historical Commission, there is a "Stub Indent" showing payment, made to estate of John Gracen, for services in the Revolutionary War. John appeared before them in July 1785 and testified to correctness of account. In Dec. 1785 he was named as deceased. There is not a record showing payment

of a pension to his widow, in existence. (Pension records in Washington, D. C. were searched.)

All of dates and names are proved in William Gracen's family—by his Bible and those of his two sons. Edward's birth and death dates are not in these Bibles—only his marriage date to Ann Sarah Burgess, and the birth dates of his first three children. According to the War Indent, Edward had to be born between the dates of his sisters' birth, 1783; and the death date on Indent of his father, Dec. 1785 (or soon after in 1786). The Indent proves the death of John, between his appearance in July 1785 and Payment made to his estate in Dec. 1785. The Census gives Edward's birth in 1787, which gives a difference of one or two years. According to his descendants, Edward died in the 1860's.

TRADITION

According to traditional facts, from descendants, we learn the following—John and Isabella (Skilling) Gracen were the first couple to come to America, S. C.—in our family. They came by boat, being married on the way over, 1775.

In an old French Bible (also lost), belonging to Isabella Skilling, there was a record. Her granddaughter, Jane Isabella Gracen (mar.—Nathaniel Rhodes) was told many times that she looked like her French grandmother.

Other descendants were taught to sew—handed down from a French ancestor. John Gracen was related to Lord Othold.

John and three brothers were children or grandchildren of Lord and Lady Gracen. This was told to a living great grandchild, by her mother and aunt—who were grandchildren of John and Isabella. Her mother was always told by her father (Edward, son of John) that her grandmother, Isabella, was French and that she looked like her, very pretty—with wavy black hair and rosy cheeks. Isabella was talented in the art of needlework—and they were all taught the art. When the estate was settled in the Old Country—John did not go back for his share.

Pertaining to "Gracen" Family or "Grayson"

My father, Mr. James W. Preacher, told me that the following was in his mother's bible. "John Gracen married Isabella Skillings in 1775."

They came to America from Ireland. They settled in Prince William Parish, Beaufort District, S. C. Isabella Skilling Gracen had a brother, William, and a sister, Kate (younger than she), who came over with them.

John and Isabella (Skillings) Gracen had three children, as follows: William was born in 1777; Elizabeth in 1783; and Edward in 1785 or 6. William moved to some other place and settled. Elizabeth never married. Edward lived in Beaufort Dist., then moved to St. Bartholomew Parish—near the present town of Walterboro, S. C.—in 1856.

The old Bible was in possession of my father's sister. She was blind, and unknown to her, must have been destroyed by her small children. This was the only record of the first Gracen couple in America that we know of. All records in Beaufort District were burned in the years of the War Between the States.

My father's grandfather, Edward Gracen, married Ann Sarah Burgis in 1816. They were parents of James Edward, Margaret Elizabeth, John Burgis, William, Arthur Bellinger, Sophia, Rebecca, Thomas and Isabella.

Isabella, after the death of her parents in 1860's, married Nathaniel Rhodes and moved to Ga. Aunt Sophia and Aunt Rebecca went to live with her, as they never did get married. Uncle John and Uncle Thomas also moved to Georgia. The others stayed in S. C. My grandmother, Margaret Elizabeth, married John Preacher in 1841. She and all of her brothers and sisters were born in Prince William Parish, Beaufort District, S. C. She was named for her Aunt Elizabeth.

James W. Preacher was son of Margaret Elizabeth (Gracen) and John Preacher. He was born September 23, 1855. I am the daughter of he and Ellen (Padgett) Preacher.

My father's mind was clear when he told me this at the age of 88. To the best of my knowledge, the above information is true.

Pertaining to "Gracen" Family or "Grayson"

I will try to tell you what I know of the family history. I am the daughter of Jane Isabella (Gracen) and Nathaniel Rhodes; and am seventy six years old. J. Isabella Gracen Rhodes was the daughter of Edward and Ann Sarah (Burgis) Gracen. She and her brothers and sisters were born in Colleton Co., S. C. Edward was the son of John and Isabella (Skilling) Gracen.

Mother always told us that our Great Grand-parents were Lord and Lady Gracen from Ireland. They spelled the name "Gracen". Later members of family changed the spelling to "Grayson".

Mother had five brothers, John, James E., William, Thomas, and Bellinger. I am not sure, but I think she had a sister, Elizabeth, who married in S. C. Aunt Sophia and Aunt Rebecca came here to Georgia to live, soon after the War Between the States. They stayed with my Mother the rest of their lives, as they never married.

There was a little Bible, always kept in Aunt Sophia's trunk. Mother and Aunt Sophia always said, "Grand mother was French". The record in the Bible must have been written in French, as we could not read it. Mother said that her Father told her that she favored her French Grandmother, and the French people. Mother was beautiful, with pretty black wavy hair and rosy cheeks. Now all of this must be true, or Grandmother would not have told her about it so much.

When my Mother died, my brother Ivy (only child at home) broke up house-keeping, and stored the things, to keep, in one room of the house; and rented it. When he went back a year later, the stored things were all gone. The little Bible was lost with these things, as were our family pictures.

I do not know dates of marriage, births, and deaths of John and Isabella (Skilling) Gracen; nor the date that they came to America.

I married, first, William I. Wiggins in 1902. I married, second, Thomas M. Pryor in 1940.

CENSUS REPORTS OF S. C.

John "Gracen" does not appear in any census reports.

1790 Census (taken 1787)—St. Helena Parish, S. C.

John Grayson—2 sons under 16—1 dau.—11 slaves—(no known connection).
Thomas Grayson—1 female over 16—2 girls under 16—41 slaves.—(unknown).
William Skilling—2 males under 16—2 females.*

*Note—Isabella Skilling (wife of John Gracen) had a brother William and a sister Kate who came over to S. C. the same time that she and John came. Since the Revolutionary War Record gives John's death between July and Dec. 1785—it appears that she and her daughter and two sons were living with her brother William in 1787 when this census was taken. He could have married which would mean then—2 sons and 1 female besides wife, possibly sister, Kate. There is no way of knowing—as the census reports did not give names in families until 1850.

The family of James Edward Gracen is not complete. However, the proof of information above was given by the following descendants. The third wife of Edward H. Gracen gave for him. He is buried at Long Branch Cemetery, near Barnwell, S. C. Julie DeLoach Garner, during her life time, established definitely her branch of the family thru her mother, Marie, and her grandfather—James Edward. She

gave the names of the brothers and sisters of her grandfather. She spoke of her uncle Edward; and, she gave family of her own sister, Daisy. She verified the fact that several of the sisters of her mother were adopted. The family of Marie are all buried at Westview Cemetery, Augusta, Ga. The inscription on tombstone of Marie is not legible for dates. Commodore Dudley Knox gave all of the information for his mother's family. He said that his mother, at the death of her mother, was adopted as a niece—by Mrs. John Butler. She was taken by her to Philadelphia, Pa., in 1833; and her name changed to Cornelia Manigault Grayson. She was bequeathed property in the will of Mrs. Butler. Mr. Knox also said that there were two other sisters adopted by Mrs. Manigault. She took them to England with her, during the Civil War. They died there without issue. A fourth daughter remained in Ga., or S. C.

Mrs. Lizzie (Hubbard) Pinckney of Bluffton, S. C. and her brother, W. R. Hubbard said that they were first cousins of Dorothy Hubbard who married James Edward Gracen.
