copy of Our Family Circle. There were no births recorded after  
that of my niece, Anne, and no deaths after that of Uncle Redding.  
One other thing was on page 275. Demcey Carol Colley Binns died  
June 15, 1943. His daughter Eleanor married Fredrick G. Mertins  
(Fredrick, III, Dec. 14, 1942 - their child?), and his son Carroll  
married Jewell Hardin.

Mary Lydia Binns Coleman (May) is dead, and none of her children  
have ever married. Her son's name was corrected from Billie Alexander  
to Billie Cozart.

Henry Hillyer Binns and his wife are dead. Their son William was  
killed in accident during World War II. He was unmarried. Their  
son Wallace married and I think is divorced now, but he did have  
children.

Milton Robert Binns and his wife are dead. Son Milton Robert, I'm  
sure is married and has children. Daughter, Mary, has never married.

My sister, Mary Blue, could probably bring you more up to date on  
what has happened to other nieces and nephews of my grandmother.

Thank you for taking my unexpected call last week—I hope it wasn't too much of an imposition—but it was nice to locate you and get to spend a few minutes speaking with you.


I would like to order a copy of your annotated version of *Our Family Circle*. I am greatly looking forward to the results of your and others' labor to refine this book. Enclosed is a money order for \$28.50 (it only cost me 19¢!).

As you mentioned that you don't like to sell the book to persons outside the 'family', I have enclosed a few of my pedigree sheets, from what I have been able to piece together, showing my ancestry to Rev. Pierre Robert and Paul Grimball (and a few other South Carolina families). I recognize that there may be a few errors.

Should it be of any interest, I'll mention that I have attempted to organize by computer most of the persons mentioned in the family history books of interest to me that I have been able to find so far, to wit, *Our Family Circle* by Annie Elizabeth Miller, *The Chaney(Cheney) Family Register—Southern Branch* by Carolyn Cloud Stanley and three Dr. G. M. G. Stafford books: *Three Pioneer Rapides Families*, *The Wells Family*, and *General Leroy Augustus Stafford*. I have over 24,000 names so far (of whom I am blood relation to over 10,000) and this is based largely on books published fifty to sixty-five years ago! (It's amazing how connected we are and how easy it is for most people to lose these connections. From my own experience, I have second cousins that until fairly recently I had never heard of!) I would like update these and add other family and allied family lines, partly because I would like to be in position to help other persons searching their family lines and I guess I find satisfaction in seeing the familial connections to so many good people of whom I previously had no knowledge. Besides, I'm also a researcher and cataloger at heart.

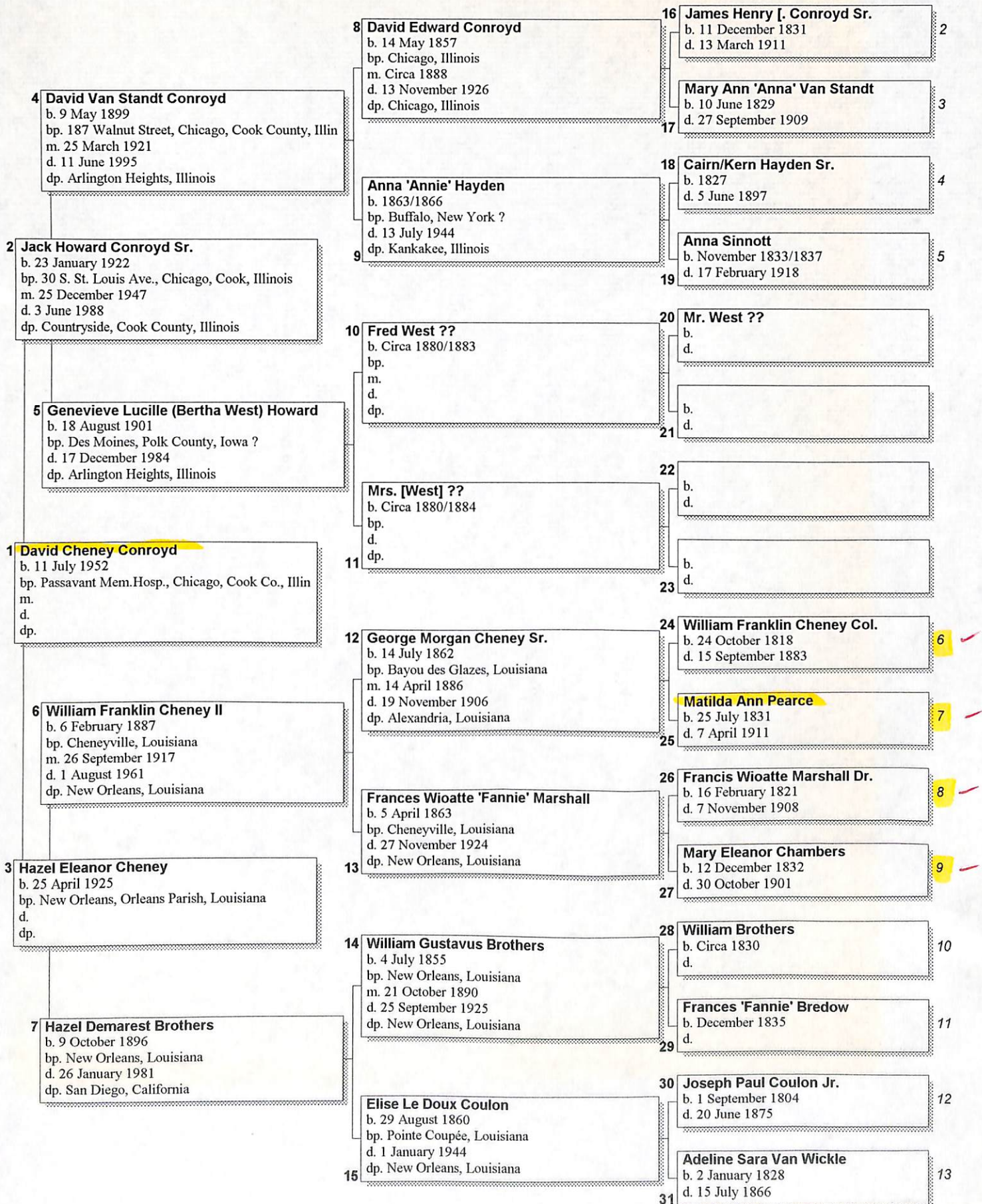
