Robert's church. There are so many contra-
dictions. A. H. Hirsch in "The Huguenots
of Colonial South Carolina" said it was
St. James Cantee, & then inferred it was
the church at the extinct town of James-
town. I am sure they are not one & the
same. Maxwell C. Davis in "Historic Berkeley
County" adds to the confusion. Once I
hired a car & spent half the day
going to St. James Cantee, convinced
that it was the right one. But last
May at the Huguenot Society they told
me that Robert's church was at Edban,
& that nothing remains at all.
