McCall) was my "eyeball", as our cousins in Georgia say, and I always felt I was the apple of his, so it is a great pleasure to document his magnificent family which seems to grow every day. I have enclosed the list of descendants as far as I can make it for now. There are blanks that I hope to close soon. I've written Mamma to come down here during Reunion Season so we can go to all of them if possible. Hopefully she will be able to and maybe bring Mary, her twin and Cousin Sue's (Lanier) mother, and maybe Aunt Aleene.

I did see Tom Lawton's ROBERT data in the Huguenot Society Transactions and was thrilled to be updated. I remember spending hours in the Bibliotheque Protestant in Paris looking up Pierre Robert and finding a whole slew of them that could have been "ours" based on dates primarily. How nice to finally know for sure.

I belong to the DAR (Rebecca Motte Chapter) through a McCall and hope to trace all my Revolutionary Ancestors - I'm not sure I'll ever be able to afford to file all the papers properly as I do believe my ancestors from both parents were of a fighting spirit and seem to have peopled our armed force handsomely. But it will be wonderful to know who they all were. I should be pleased to learn about the Mathews Davant heritage.

I'm thrilled about the endeavour to document the Robert descendants and with the memorial tablet for St. James. I do hope we can keep the vandals away. I was down at the church not too long ago and thought at the time that I should spend a few Sunday afternoons tidying up the grave yard. 
