I now embrace the opportunity of writing you a few lines to inform you that I am well and hope these few lines will find you ^{all} the same I received the box you sent by James Shitt yesterday and I thank you for sending them I ~~have~~ ^{nothing} of much importance to write at present as you will get all the news as you have desired yesterday. I have not yet written for you and I drawed mine later in the week more goes home my twin will come you do you must not be uneasy about me as I will be sure to do what is right and keep out of all mischief tell Ma that not to fret about me as I am doing well I have plenty of bed clothes after my best respects to you and all the family I must come to close write soon and give me all the news nothing more but remains your loving
