1. SARAH BARKSDALE, born c. 1714 Christ Church Parish, probably died young. On February 28, 1716, John Barksdale, the immigrant, did "give and grant [property] to my Loveing Grandaughter Sarah Barksdale Daughter of the Said Thomas Barksdale . . . "63 No further record of this Sarah Barksdale has been located.

(4) 2. CHARLES BARKSDALE, born July 3, 1715, Christ Church Parish, died 1757 Christ Church Parish; married Mrs. Mary (Sasseau)

Wingood.

3. THOMAS BARKSDALE, born c. 1719, died c. 1755 Christ Church Parish. In 1749, Thomas Barksdale, Jr., served as one of the executors of the will of his uncle, Joseph Vanderhorst. Both he and his brother, George Barksdale, were named executors in the will of his brother-in-law, John Miller. 64 Thomas Barksdale, Jr., died in 1755 without any immediate heirs when on February 3 of that year, property "formerly in the possession of Thomas Barksdale, Jun., dec'd" was conveyed by the senior Thomas Barksdale to his elder son, Charles. 65

(5) 4. GEORGE BARKSDALE, born c. 1721/2 Christ Church Parish, died 1781 Charles Town or Christ Church Parish; married (1) Mary

(Cochran?), (2) Susannah Stone, (3) Elizabeth Patterson.

(6) 5. HANNAH BARKSDALE, born 1732 Christ Church Parish, died 1780 "Newington" plantation, Effingham County, Georgia; married (1) John Miller, (2) Nathaniel Polhill, (3) Reverend Benjamin Stirk, (4) Reverend Alexander H. Scott.

6. ELIZABETH BARKSDALE, born 1734, probably Christ Church Parish, baptized October 20, 1734 at the Independent or Congregational (Circular) Church in Charles Town by Reverend Nathan Bassett. Elizabeth Barksdale was alive and unmarried in 1755 when she witnessed a deed from her sister, Hannah, and her father, Thomas Barksdale, to Nathan Tart.
