

Articles of agreement made and concluded between James Gray
on the one part and Elizabeth Green on the other Part testifies—
First that the said James Gray doth obligate himself to build or
cause to be built to her the said Elizabeth Green a House in the
following Manner and Form, etc. First the Dimension of the House
Thirty four Feet long and Nineteen wide, to be framed feathered
-boarded and shingled, in a workmanship like Manner with Dutch
Roof and five Dorman Windows and four gable End Windows, also
to have two floors planned a Stair Case leading Windows below with
sattens, two outside Doors, one Chamber Door, one Elbow Door
below; also shieling and basboards in the rooms below one Closet
one Rooflet, a slab to Chimney, the weather Board to be planed,
the Windows below to be prepared for sashes and also a boarded
Porch below, the whole to be done in a plain and Workmanlike
Manner also one partition of wood. Secondly, If the said
Elizabeth Green do obligate myself by this present agreement to
pay the said James Gray and his or whosoever he may employ
in sufficient Meet, drink ~~drinking~~ and lodging also to him
and every one that he may employ One Bushel of corn to each
Man and sugar equivalent. I do hereby oblige and bind
myself my Heirs and Administrators. In the Penal Sum of
Six hundred Pounds lawful Money of South Carolina to be paid
to the said James Gray his Heirs or Assigns jointly by these
Presente Testimony whereof I do hereunto set my hand and
Seal this seventh Day of December in the Year of our Lord
One thousand seven hundred and sixty Seven—

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the
above bounden Elizabeth Green she her Heirs or Executors, do
well and truly pay to the above named James Gray, his Heirs
or Assigns the just sum of Three hundred Pounds, when he
the said James Gray do well and truly build or cause to be
built the said House above described with putting single
Architraves around the Doors and Windows below then
the above Obligation to be void; or else to remain in full
Power & Virtue.
